

## TUX Yarding Challenge & Handy Dog Events Rule Amendments

***The following two rulings were passed by the NZSDTA Executive Covid-19 AGM 20<sup>th</sup> May 2020***

**TUX Handy Dog Event** - 'if you qualify two dogs for a North Island or New Zealand final you should be allowed to take both dogs' ***Explanation*** – this refers to the TUX Handy Dog Event which will bring it into line with the TUX Yarding Challenge Event

**TUX Yarding Challenge Event** - At the bridge, competitor may clear sheep off the bridge either by walking onto the bridge or alongside the bridge. If competitor and dog walk down the same side of the bridge and then one or other cross in front of bridge, it is deemed to be crossing in the drive and will be under penalty'

***The following ruling was passed by NZSDTA Council 19<sup>th</sup> May 2021***

**“Yarding Challenge and Handy Dog Event** - at an Island final, if the reserve judge is called upon to judge and does so, and has already qualified a dog to run in that Island run-off, they become eligible to compete in the regional competition in the other Island hosting the NZ run-off. If fortunate to qualify there, they may go onto that Island and NZ run-off.”
